
### Indraprastha College for Women

#### **Report for Session 2021 - 22**

In line with the College's mandate of enhancing the Alumnae Network, this year was fruitful in engaging with alumnae. As the world attempted to return to the physical mode from the online mode, this year had both online and offline interactions with our Alumnae.

Keeping the earmarked calendar date of the Second Sunday of November, 14 November 2021, we hosted the Annual Alumnae Meet online. All departments continued to establish effective communication channels with their alumnae by inviting them for Talks, Meets, Workshops, Student guidance or in the capacity of Judges for various events over Google Meet/ Zoom and then some events in person once the college reopened in February 2022. With the help of dedicated and responsive Departmental Alumnae Representatives, both the practice of updating Alumnae databases as well as engaging with alumnae have become regular events on the Academic Calendar. Our dedicated Google Group has nearly 3100 members and is growing. This year we also started a Facebook Group (https://www.facebook.com/groups/596523204874379/) to connect with our alumnae and it has 1960 members and is growing. The Facebook group has become an active platform for sharing memories of being associated with the College and its glorious past.







In addition to the departmental engagements with the alumnae, many other collaborations under the aegis of IQAC were organised.


The third edition of the Annual Shahzad R. 

*Samvaad-* The Hindi Debating Society of the College hosted an online debating basics workshop on 9 March 2022 with Ms. Angarika




Datta, an alumna of the College and also the President of the Debating Society (2011-2012).

#### **Annual Alumnae Meet**






Performances by Alaap and Mridang





#### **Department Alumnae Events**








Alumna Talk in the Philosophy Department











