

## REPORT (1 JUNE 2021- 31 MAY 2022)

### SANSKRIT STUDIES AND RESEARCH CENTRE

In 2021-22, *Sanskrit Studies and Research Centre*, Indraprastha College for Women organised many programmes related with Academics and Research for the students of different disciplines with the purpose to equip them with the Indian Knowledge Tradition enshrined in Sanskrit Language. Programmes organized throughout the year are as follow:

On June 30, 2021 an Inter College Paper Presentation Webinar on *Saṁskṛta Vāṅmaya mein Nihita Jñāna-Vijñāna Paramparā* was organized by the SSRC & Department of Sanskrit. Papers were invited from all the Colleges of University of Delhi from all the students of different disciplines and **14 Papers** were screened for the presentation. **Dr. Anita Swami and Dr. Maya Verma** were the **Judges** of the event. Presentations of the students were excellent and appreciated by the Judges. Prizes were given to the students for the best papers and E-certificates awarded to all the paper presenters.

On Oct 21, 2021 SSRC & Department of Sanskrit organized many programmes on the occasion of Sanskrit Day Celebration. A special lecture titled *Bhāratīya Saṁskṛti ke Saṁrakṣaṇa mein Saṁskṛta kā Yogadāna* was delivered by the guest speaker Dr. Dharma Sharma Alumna, Indraprastha College for Women (Batch: 1964-1970) Retd. Associate Professor, Lakshmbai College, D.U. The webinar was thoroughly enjoyed by the students and teachers and also made them aware about the role of Sanskrit in the New Education Policy.

On April 20, 2022 an Inter College Paper Presentation titled *Bhāratīya-Jñāna-Paramparā mein Vāstu-Vidyā* was organized by the SSRC & Department of Sanskrit. Papers were invited from all the Colleges of University of Delhi from all the students of different disciplines and 21 Papers were screened for the presentation. **Dr. Babli Moitra Saraf, Principal, Indraprastha College for Women** inaugurated the programme with the objectives of SSRC and also motivated students towards research in Sanskrit.
